Viz:

1       At the appropriate place in title VIII of division A,  
2 insert the following:

3       SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. (a) Not later than one year after the  
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General  
5 of the United States shall, in consultation with the Sec-  
6 retary of Defense and the Secretaries of the military de-  
7 partments, submit to the appropriate committees of Con-  
8 gress a report on the monitoring, compliance, and remedi-  
9 ation by the Department of Defense of lead in military

1 housing, including the lead exposure monitoring protocols  
2 of the Department for military housing.

3 (b) The report required by subsection (a) shall in-  
4 clude the following:

5 (1) A description and assessment of the effec-  
6 tiveness of the Department and its lead exposure  
7 monitoring protocols in monitoring lead exposure in  
8 military housing.

9 (2) A description and assessment of the compli-  
10 ance of military housing with applicable lead expo-  
11 sure limitations.

12 (3) A description and assessment of the remedi-  
13 ation efforts of the Department with respect to lead  
14 in military housing.

15 (4) Such recommendations as the Comptroller  
16 General considers appropriate for the expansion of  
17 blood testing for lead among children who have lived  
18 in military housing.

19 (c) In this section, the term “appropriate committees  
20 of Congress” means—

21 (1) the Committee on Armed Services, the  
22 Committee on Veterans’ Affairs, and the Committee  
23 on Appropriations of the Senate; and

1           (2) the Committee on Armed Services, the  
2           Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and the Committee  
3           on Appropriations of the House of Representatives.
